Requirements and Instructions:

- Applicant must be accepted into the Our Lady of the Lake University MA in Teaching or the Master's in Education (MEd) program with concentrations in bilingual education and/or special education
- Applicant must be a U. S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Applicant must be eligible to receive a scholarship according to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- The amount an applicant is eligible to receive is determined by the PPOHA Scholarship Committee based on the FAFSA EFC code.
- The scholarship will be awarded for fall, spring and summer. However, the subsequent term award is contingent upon completing prior term courses in good academic standing.
- Scholarships will be automatically renewed based on academic standing through Fall 2027.
